COMPLAINT AGAINST POLICE

Thank you for your email to this office about your complaint against police, the contents of which have been noted.

Some of the points raised, (2,3 and 5) are closely related to matters which are currently under investigation and therefore it would be inappropriate to investigate these matters at this time.

Once the investigation and any subsequent criminal proceedings have concluded, you will receive correspondence about these elements of the complaint so they can be progressed.

Should you object to the decision to suspend the handling of your complaint, you may ask the IOPC to consider whether to direct that the complaint handling continue.
